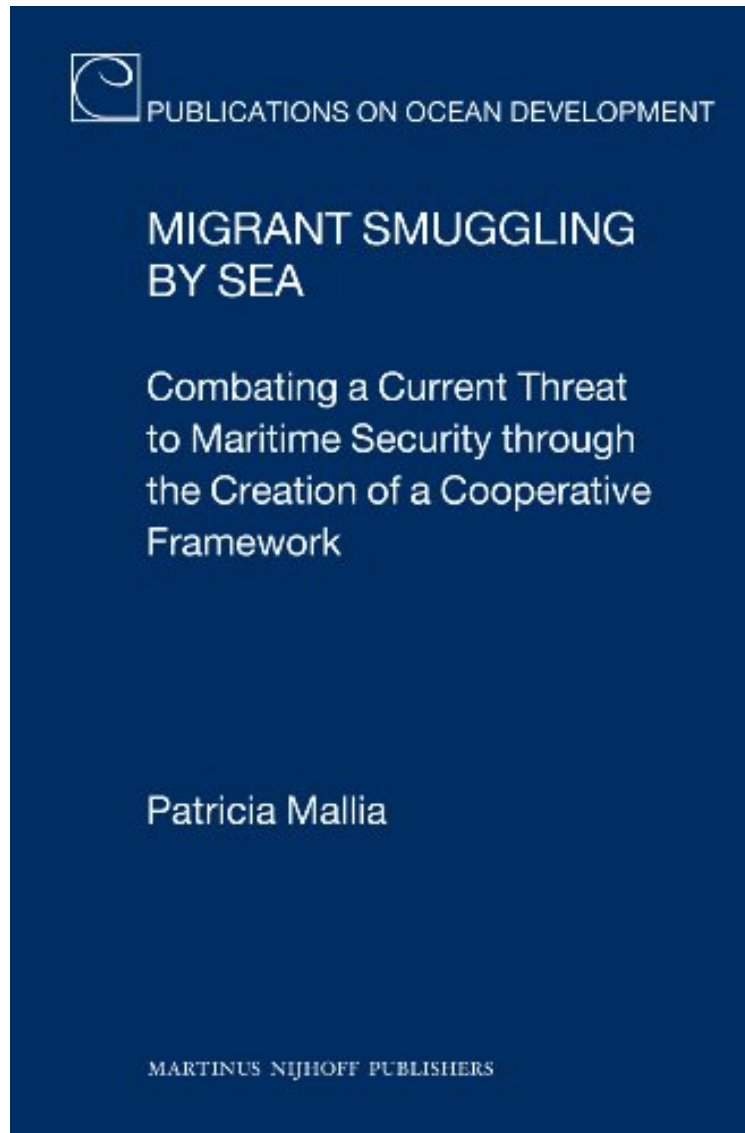

A number of rules of the international law governing the oceans were created at a time far removed from the challenges of the present day.
