I could not have navigated the highly ambiguous and sometimes contradictory statutes of patent law without this excellent book, written by a guy who has worked both as a patent attorney and USPTO examiner. I will note that, though the author stresses that 'anyone' can write their own patent, with some hard work and determination- I will submit that you will have to have a mind for analysis, a somewhat advanced vocabulary, and that depending on your invention you will have to do a lot of research, and have a lot of time on your hands. That said, this book offers you the potential to save yourself tons of money- It's still somewhat of a gamble, because you will be submitting a patent with an unseasoned understanding of patent law, newly garnered from a book. Be warned there are issues that can arise from this, and that if you have the funds to pay a good patent attorney, you should. This book provides a very clear guide for those who are willing to read, re-read and attentively study it's contents, in order that one may make the most educated choices (and sometimes guesses) during the writing of one's own patent. If you are good at splitting hairs, have a good vocabulary, have time, and do not have \$5-20K to spend on a potential patenting costs through the use of a patent attorney, this book is for you.
