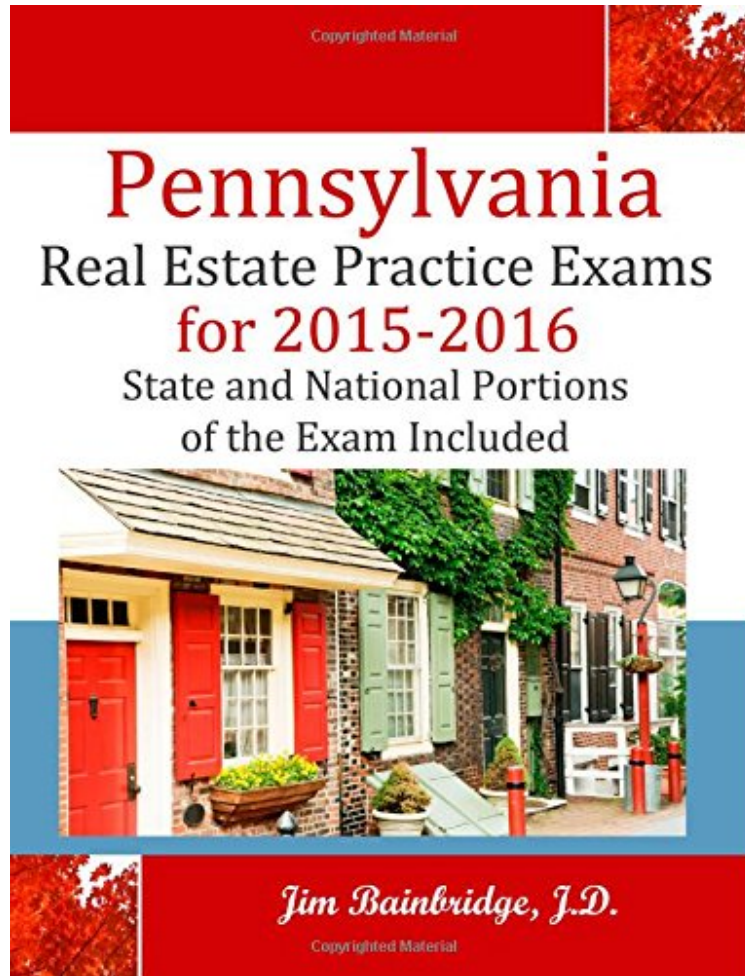

Contrary to what one reviewer said, this book DOES have PA-specific questions. In fact, it states at the beginning of each practice exam that the first 30 questions are state-specific, and there were a few as I look now at the book that were very much on-point with the actual exam. Also, some of the questions and answers covered topics in better detail that my main text (see end of review for book name), which absolutely came in handy earlier today. There is definitely some convoluted language in the questions (many use double

negatives, and a few seem to focus on too much nuance), but I found that using "harder" questions to practice allowed me to absorb more of the information. My main issue is that I don't find a high majority of the answers "detailed"; many of them are simply repeating the question with the answer as the rest of the sentence. Overall, I would still suggest this as one of a few resources to use.
