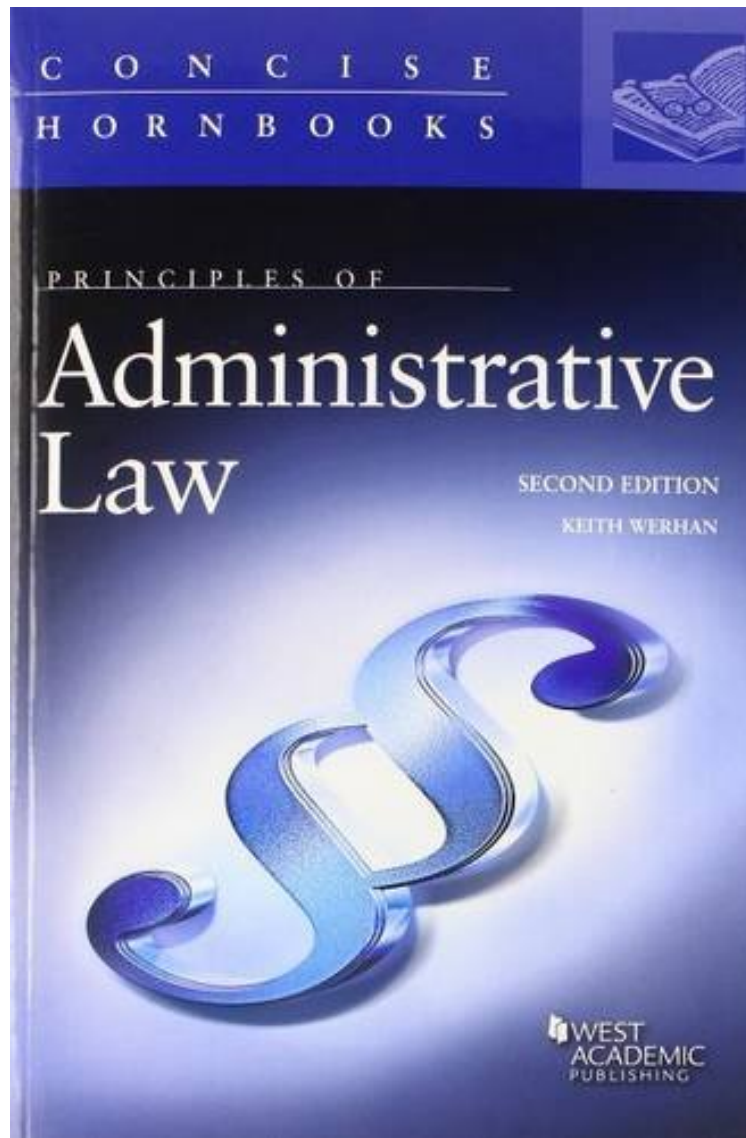

This is the first text I've found that clearly explains the law, without skipping steps or making assumptions. I am relieved to have finally found this. The writing is straight-forward but eloquent. The author gives you a sense of the big picture, and I have yet to discover any other book that so clearly lays out the basics in a comprehensive manner. Many other texts make annoying assumptions (such as equating a question of law to a legal interpretation) that can confuse the reader. This book provides an accessible, yet sophisticated treatment of the essential principles of administrative law. Topics covered include a history of the American administrative state; theories of agency behavior; separation of powers and procedural due process, as they are implicated by the administrative process; the procedural framework of the Administrative Procedure Act; formal adjudicatory procedure; informal rulemaking procedure; and the availability, timing, and scope of judicial review. The book includes charts and diagrams that assist the reader in visualizing the major elements of the administrative process.
