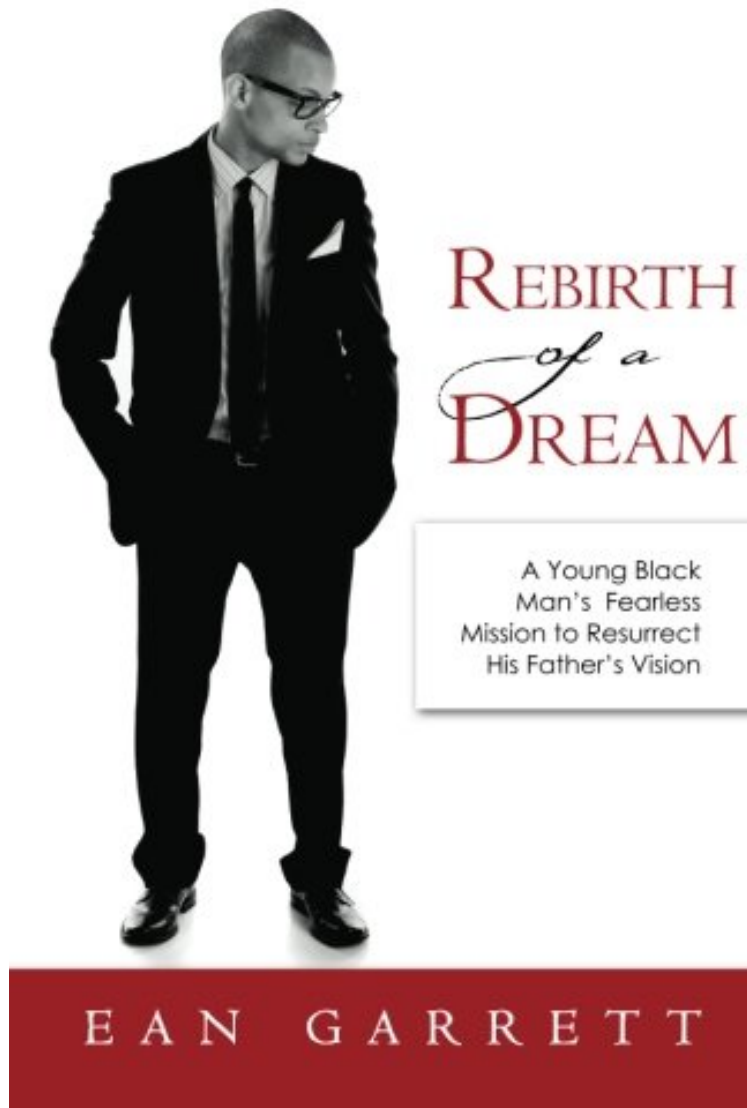

Ean also successfully completed international coursework at CBL Internationals Law School in Dubai, U.A.E., in 2011/2012. Ean has been heavily invested in furthering the causes of at-risk youth.
