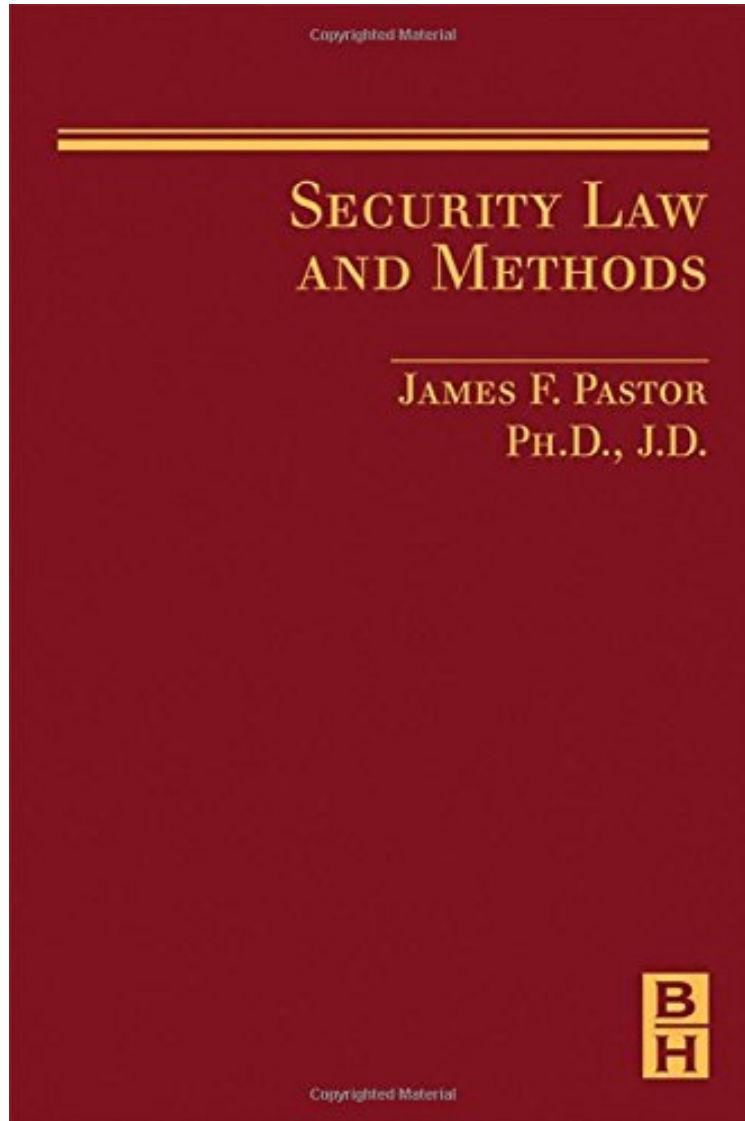

It's not a difficult read if you have a basic understanding of law. You don't need to have taken a law class or be an attorney to understand this book. What you do need are 1) a desire to learn a bit of security law and some of the law methods, and 2) a desire to learn about some of the key legal cases that

can impact interpretation of laws in security operations. Understanding these few cases will help the security manager understand some of the possible legal nuances of laws that directly impact security. Pastor breaks each case down into easily digested pieces for impacts against the case, law and the correlation between the two.
