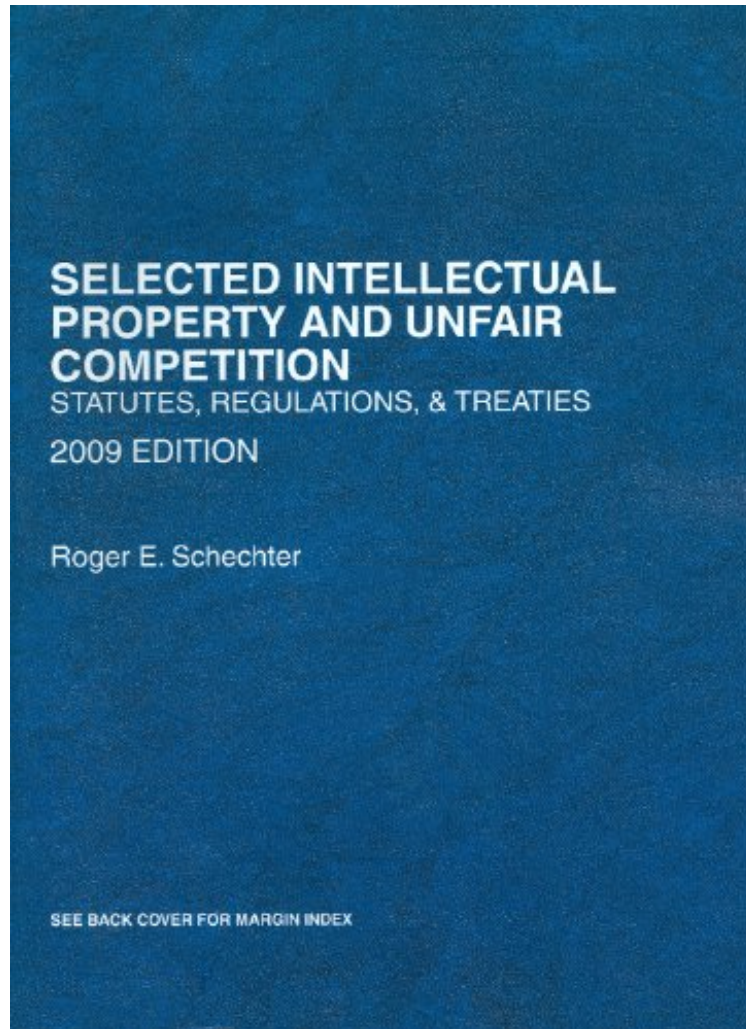

It is just like a normal procedural book, with a blackened stripe on the edge of the page in which the section starts, and an arrow on the back cover that defines what is in the pages that have the black stripe in that location. But ALL of the pages within a section should be blackened, here it is only the first page. It is hard to find what they are directing you to. Also, the same index is a little off center. When the back page points to a

certain page, the arrow is about 1/2 inch off, making it utterly confusing. The pages are flimsy and it is hard to hold.
